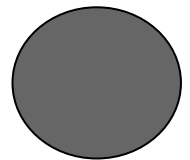
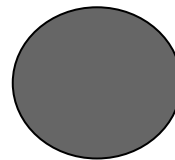
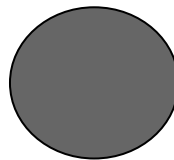

SCHEDULE

Summer School will be in session Wednesday, May 30 thru Tuesday, June 26. Students will attend school from 7:54 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Students will be placed in a homeroom class where they will learn reading, writing, math, and science skills with a theme based approach. The teacher will share a hobby they are passionate about with students for approximately an hour each day. These shared passions may include camping, fishing, video games, veterinary work, science experiments, etc. Third, fourth, and fifth graders will stay with their homeroom teacher for 5 to 6 days before rotating to a different teacher for a new experience. Your child's summer school grade level will be the grade your child is entering in the fall.

NOTE: Students will not need to sign up for elective classes. These fun activities will be included in their classes. Students will be placed in the classes, and rotate to experience a variety of activities throughout summer school.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

Breakfast & lunch will be offered each day FREE to all children through age 18. This is sponsored by Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and USDA. Breakfast and lunch will be served in the Eugene Field cafeteria.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

For guaranteed bus services starting the first day, your student must be enrolled by the **May 10** deadline. Be sure to fill out the transportation section within the enrollment form. Any enrollments after May 10 may not be provided transportation until the 2nd week of summer school. A letter will be sent home before school is out with your child's transportation information listed. PARENT DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

3rd – 5th grade students should be dropped off at the West Street doors if arriving before 7:54. There will be a summer school employee at the crosswalk until 7:54. Students who arrive after 7:54 need to be dropped off at the front doors. After 7:54 the adult on duty will have to report inside for duty leaving this door unattended. For the safety of students the West Street door will be locked at 7:54.

Buses only will be permitted to enter the one way street in front of the school. At 2:55 bus riders will exit through the front doors. At 3:00 car riders will exit from the West Street doors and walkers will exit from the Boulevard or playground doors.

Late drop-offs and early pick-ups: If your child arrives late, or you need to pick them up early, please enter the front doors and check in with the office.
