Dear Mexico 59 Parents:

To ensure transparency and convey important information, we wanted to share today's update from the Audrain County Health Department. As of 1:00 p.m., there are no confirmed cases in our county. In regards to the MMS staff member who tested positive last week, here is the statement:

*"Audrain County Health Department has not observed any surge in the number of residents requiring testing as a result of the Mexico Middle School (MMS) potential exposure. The MMS risk of transmission was low and all associated were urged to contact their healthcare provider to determine if testing was needed. Only those who have been instructed by their healthcare provider should remain at home and not go to work. **ACHD is unaware of any person who was instructed by a provider to remain home as a result of this incident.**"*
